Dear Bellevue Table Tennis Club Board,

We value the program that the Club has provided to the Crossroads Community Center and to the great table tennis community over the past years. In follow-up to our letter dated August 2, 2022, after our individual meetings last week with Quentin Ye and Jerry Li, we have decided at this time to terminate the Club's Agreement for Services with the City of Bellevue dated December 14, 2021, and to terminate the Club's current Sunday rental agreement. This termination shall become effective in seven days on September 15, 2022.

This determination was based on the stated inability for Mr. Ye and Mr. Li to be able to be together at the Crossroads Community Center during BTTC programs without their differences continuing to escalate or without the need for Crossroads Community Center staff intervention. The City, takes no position regarding differences between these individuals or conflicts involving the Club, but remains concerned about the safety of its visitors and staff should the Club continue to operate its programs at the Crossroads Community Center. Further, we are unclear as to the current direction and leadership of the Club. As a result, we feel it is in the City's best interests to end its Agreement for Services and rental agreement with the Club at this time.

Please note, that City staff are unable to help mediate this conflict within the Club, and we request that you refrain from attempting to involve staff in this conflict.
